## POINTERS ON PETS

PLANNING AND PREPARATION ARE ESSENTIAL WHEN TRAVELING WITH FAMILY PETS. A FEW GENERAL TIPS APPLY WHETHER YOU ARE GOING BY CAR OR PLANE. BE SURE YOUR PET IS PROPERLY IDENTIFIED WITH A CURRENT TAG OR MICROCHIP. HAVE BOTH PROOF OF RABIES VACCINATION AND A CURRENT HEALTH CERTIFICATE WITH YOU WHEN CROSSING BORDERS. BRINGING ITS FAVORITE FOOD, TOYS AND DISHES WILL ALSO HELP MAKE YOUR PET MORE COMFORTABLE. IF YOU WILL BE STAYING WITH FRIENDS ALONG THE WAY, BE CONSIDERATE. FIND OUT IN ADVANCE IF THE PET IS WELCOME. THE SAME GOES FOR HOTELS, MOTELS, PARKS AND CAMPGROUNDS. ALWAYS CHECK WHETHER PETS ARE ALLOWED OR KENNEL FACILITIES ARE AVAILABLE. MAKE SURE YOUR PET IS IN GOOD PHYSICAL HEALTH BEFORE YOU TRAVEL. PICK UP REFILLS OF ANY MEDICATIONS YOUR PET WILL NEED—AND FIND OUT WHETHER OR NOT THERE ARE ANY CONCERNS ABOUT THE PLACE TO WHICH YOU ARE TRAVELING. INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL PARASITE PREVENTIVES ARE ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER.
